Title of the communication (maximum 25 words), in capital letters and Times New Roman of 12 points. Name, direction, telephone and electronic mail of or the authors of the communication. Summary of the communication (200 words) written of continuous way (without separated paragraphs) to simple space with letter Times New Roman of 12 points. It will have to be aligned to the left and not to use subtitles not abbreviations.

2) Before the 30 of May of 2010, the interested in organizing a symposium, will have to put under a proposal in writing the organizing committee of the event, with the title of the symposium, names and institutions of the organizers, a brief description of the subject and the potential participants. Before August 30 2010, once the committee approves the subject of the symposium, the organizers will have to put under a formal proposal.
